

The Westminster School PE Sports Funding

From September 2013 each school received extra sports funding through Sports Pupil Premium. At The Westminster School this amounted to £3436 (up to April 2014). We have used this funding to improve the PE experiences that the children have in school and to develop their experience of Healthy Lifestyles outside school. We feel that this is the most effective and efficient way for the funding to have a long lasting and positive effect on future learning and physical development of children within our school.

BUDGET - £3436 SPENDING TO DATE:

£748 for Swimming Sessions at Haden Hill Swimming Pool including travel £260 for PE coach to deliver Dance (Autumn Term) £260 for PE coach to deliver Gymnastics (Spring Term) £1250 for West Bromwich Albion coach

In addition we are considering the long term impact of the funding and working to ensure that its effects are sustained. In order to do this we will be supporting staff to develop their skills in teaching and leading high quality Physical Education across the curriculum.

Opportunities for this Professional Development will focus on gymnastics, team sports and games in line with Primary Curriculum 2014.

HOW THE IMPACT WILL BE MEASURED:-

- Greater confidence in planning and delivery of Primary Curriculum 2014.
 Measured by observations of children and staff during PE lessons, teachers to use CPD training to run own clubs.
- Better Assessment of pupil's skills and planning for development in PE. Measured by – More accurate planning for all pupils and outstanding progress made.
- Increased attendance in after school clubs and participation in PE and sport outside school
 Measured by feedback from pupils and parents.
