Dear Parents/Carers

Return to School for Students in 10.1, 11.1 and on Route 9

We have received notification of further positive cases of COVID within the School community.

Following the advice given to us by Public Health England, Public Health Sandwell and the Local Authority this morning, students from 10.1, 11.1 and on Route 9 will need to continue to self-isolate until Thursday 1 July. **Unless your child develops symptoms, they can return to school on Friday 2 July.**

If your child develops any of the following symptoms, **however minor**, please arrange a PCR test through <https://www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test> or by calling 119:

- new continuous cough and/or
- high temperature and/or
- a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)
- headaches
- aches and pains
- feeling very tired for no good reason
- sore throat
- runny nose
- sneezing
- tummy ache/upset tummy in children.

If your child tests positive, please ring the school on 0121 561 6884 and let us know.
